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Appendix A - Describes the club practice, play, plans and schedules

- Practice two (2) nights per week 7-9pm December – May
- Practices will be held at Highline Community College
- Parents are welcome to attend practice
- Siblings **MUST** be **CLOSLY SUPERVISED** if brought to practice
- Play in a minimum of 2 tournament dates per month Jan – May
- The practice and play schedule will be posted to the Club Website by early December

Appendix B - Describes the other things the club dues will/will not pay for, ie uniforms, travel costs, food, etc

- Club dues **will cover**... Coaches Stipend, Gym Rental, Tournament fees as described
- Club dues **do not cover**... Travel, accommodations, nor food while traveling
- Initiation Fees **will cover**... 2 Uniforms, 2 Practice Tees, 1 pr shorts Sweat top, Sweat Pant (for players above U12),
- Equipment purchase, Misc. team expenses

Appendix C - Describes the Financial arrangements/plans and schedules

- Monthly dues range from \$175 - \$225 depending upon age and type of team
- Dues are due the 5th of the month and considered late on the 10th of the month
- There is a \$25 late fee assessed for late payments
- We have a 10% reduction for returning members or 2nd family members playing
- We have opportunities for parents to work at the SFY hosted tournaments at a rate of \$10 per hour.
